PROCLAMATION

TO ALL TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY COME, GREETINGS:

- WHEREAS, Residents of Indiana are encouraged to get a higher education or advanced training skills to help with their vocational goals; and
- WHEREAS, Financial aid is available for students to help with the costs associated with attending college; and
- WHEREAS, Completing the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) is the major document used for this purpose; and
- WHEREAS, February 15, 2009 is the 20th Annual Indiana College Goal Sunday event sponsored jointly by the Indiana Student Financial Aid Association and the State Student Assistance Commission of Indiana, with funding from the Lilly Endowment, Inc., to help families with this process; and
- WHEREAS, All Indiana residents are encouraged to complete the FAFSA application process by the State of Indiana deadline of March 10, 2009;
