FEDERAL STUDENT AID ACCOUNT (Students & Parents)

- Every student AND parent should create a Federal Student Aid Account at studentaid.gov. This will serve as your electronic signature on the FAFSA.

PERSONAL DOCUMENTS (Students & Parents)

- Social Security Number
- Driver's License Number
- Alien registration number or permanent resident card if you are not a U.S. Citizen

TAX DOCUMENTS & PROOF OF INCOME (Students & Parents)

- 2024 Federal Income Tax Return if you were required to file.
- 2024 W-2 forms or other records of money earned or received.

ASSETS (Students & Parents)

- Bank Statements (Cash, Savings, & Checking)
- Child support received in the past calendar year
- Current value of investment accounts (non-retirement) and real-estate (excluding the home you live in)
- Current net worth of any ownership in a business or farm
